

CURBSIDE RECYCLING



Accepted materials for residential customers



No plastic bags or wrap, no bagged recyclables. All items must be empty, clean (quick rinse), with no lids.

Metal



Pots and pans



Aluminum and tin cans (lids okay if attached)

Glass

Put glass bottles and jars in a separate recycling bin.



(no lids or caps)

Paper and Cardboard



Cardboard (flattened)



Magazines, catalogs, newspapers, and mail



Cereal and food boxes

Plastic

Recycle plastics by shape. Ignore numbers/symbols on packaging.



Plastic buckets (no lids or handles)



Rigid plastic plant pots



Dairy tubs and yogurt cups (no caps or lids)



Plastic bottles, jugs, and jars (no caps or lids)

If you are unsure which items go in your recycle cart, the rule of thumb is "When in doubt, leave it out."

Styrofoam® blocks and food containers



Styrofoam® must be clean and have this symbol.

Recycle Styrofoam® at:

- The Waste and Recovery Center (WARC) at 2420 Hogum Bay Road NE in Hawks Prairie. Put Styrofoam® in a clear plastic bag provided on-site.
- DART Container Corp. at 600 Israel Road SE in Tumwater.

Household hazardous waste

Take products that say CAUTION, WARNING, DANGER, or POISON to HazoHouse at the Thurston County Waste and Recovery Center. Service is free for residents.



Never put hazardous chemicals in the trash or down the drain. For more information call 360-867-2912.
