The Washington State 4-H Fair Board is a volunteer group of 12 adults and two volunteers, who in conjunction with staff members, put on the Washington State 4-H Fair in September of each year in Puyallup.

Following the WA State 4-H Council meeting this past weekend, there are several vacant positions on the board: Position NW 1 – an adult position from the NW district Position SE 1 – an adult position from the SE district Position SE 3 – an adult position from the SE district Position NE 3 – an adult position from the NE district Position Youth 1 – a youth position from anywhere in the state

While the length of the positions vary from 1-3 years, we will be filling all position for a one-year term that will expire in October 2020.
