

NEW!!! All-Around *Virtual* Exhibitor

Award Purpose: To recognize 4-H youth who demonstrate extraordinary effort to virtually exhibit 4-H project work during these challenging times. An All-Around Virtual Exhibitor will have pursued county and/or state level virtual exhibition opportunities. An All-Around Virtual Exhibitor may have also showcased project skills and knowledge via 4-H partner organization contests such as those hosted by breed organizations and hobby clubs.

An All-Around Virtual Exhibitor's entries are a diverse example of quality 4-H project work. For example, the All-Around Virtual Exhibitor may participate in online competitions by entering still life projects such as photography and fine arts, animal costume contests, submitting educational displays, participating in a judging contest, giving a public presentation via zoom, or completing a record book for the Virtual 2020 Achievement Celebration. Everyone who applies and qualifies at a high level of achievement will receive recognition.

Qualifications: To be nominated for the All-Around Virtual Exhibitor of the Year award, youth must exhibit in more than one project area and compete in a variety of general 4-H contest areas.
