4-H Council - Monthly 4-H Council (County-Wide Advisory Board) meetings are held the 4th Monday of the month via Zoom and sometimes in-person. Watch for announcements/invites to in-person meetings which include Fair Superintendents (in-person meetings October, April, and July).

Horse Committee - Monthly committee meetings for horse club leaders, horse fair superintendents, and teen leaders to coordinate/plan horse events. Meetings are held at the WSU Extension 4-H Office the first Monday of the month unless otherwise announced.

Petersen Barn Committee - Quarterly committee meetings for small animal (cat, rabbit, cavy, pocket pets, and poultry) club leaders, Petersen Barn fair superintendents, and teen leaders to coordinate/plan Petersen Barn events. Meetings are normally held via Zoom on Thursday evenings unless otherwise announced.

Thurston County Fair Board - Monthly Fair Board meetings are held the first Wednesday of the month in Heritage Hall unless otherwise announced. Note: The Fair Board is not a 4-H entity but rather a partner organization.

- If you are new to 4-H, attend an Introduction to 4-H Presentation for parents/guardians.
- Talk to your 4-H Club Leader and ask about parent participation. Often it is helpful for parents to attend club and/or project meetings so you can support 4-H project work completion/practice at home.
- Interested in County and/or State Fair? Consider fair schedules when planning family vacations and work leave requests so you are available to support your child or children while exhibiting.
- Read the Thurston County Fair Exhibitor Guide rules and entry instructions.
- Read the State 4-H Fair Exhibitor Guide (for youth who qualify for State 4-H Fair participation).


