


THE GOAL:

How do I purchase?

1) TURNING/RE-SELLING:

Option 1) Sell for you (the buyer) through the SWW Junior Livestock Committee at a predetermined market floor price, established the day of the sale.

“TURN” Examples:

Buyer bids \$3.20/lb. on a 1,200 lb. steer.
Floor price is \$1.25/lb. on beef

\$4.00 x 1,200 lb. = \$ 4,800
\$1.25 x 1,200 lb. = \$ -1,500
\$ 3,300

Buyer's cost is \$3,300.00 to support the steer.

(Floor price = what regional wholesale market price per pound is on the day of the sale).

The average price per pound for 2018 for each species was as follows:

Beef \$ 4.06 /lb. Swine \$ 7.54 /lb.
Sheep \$ 7.77 /lb. Goat \$ 9.03 /lb.
Turkey - \$16.63 / lb.
Poultry -pen of 3- \$23.42/ lb.
Rabbits-pen of 3- \$25.36/ lb.

Purchase of an animal or donation may be tax deductible. Our 501 c 3 tax I.D. EIN for the SWJLSC is 91-6048845.

Option 2) Re-sell for you (the buyer) at Chehalis Livestock Auction. Chehalis Livestock Auction will auction off your animal the following day and deduct a commission and send you a payment for the animal.

2) PURCHASING OUTRIGHT:

By purchasing a steer, lamb, hog or market goat for custom processing or obtaining meat for the family freezer. This will involve some additional cost for initial processing, cutting and wrapping.



PURCHASING OUTRIGHT Cont.:

- ◆ Purchases are made on live weight.
- ◆ All processing costs are in addition to purchase price and are figured on hanging weight of carcass, cost will also include slaughter fees to be posted the night of the sale
- ◆ Costs are on a per pound basis and will vary according to your cut and wrap shop.
- ◆ Smoking costs for ham and bacon curing are in addition to cut and wrap costs.
- ◆ Poultry and rabbits are sold in a pen of 3 or 4, some poultry as singles, and take home for processing or turn to local small animal auction, see turning.

3) An animal may be purchased by more than one individual/business if you wish to split an animal. The buyers must make their own arrangements to do this and bid as one entity. (Example: Bob Brown and Whitney White arrange to each buy one half of Sally Smart's hog. They bid as Brown-White and each buyer is responsible for 1/2 of the purchase price and pays the Market Sale Treasurer.)

4) DONATION/ADD-ON:

By contributing any amount of money to an individual or group of youth through the Southwest Washington Junior Livestock Sale to distribute to participating youth.





is dedicated to the promotion of Washington agriculture, economic growth, and ecology. The youth of FFA are educated in the


industry of agriculture. Skills of showmanship, display, and confidence are combined with the development of agricultural leadership.
