- Any animal that is 7/8ths or more of a breed must be shown as purebred.
- Any animal that is less than 7/8ths of a breed must be shown as crossbred.

Photos and video for judging.

For fitting and showing: 3-5 minute video showing walking in circle, setting up, handler changing side.

Breed Type: submit photos of front view, side view, and back view.

Lots for Classes 2-3

Lot A - Junior Heifer Calf (Calved between January 1 and March 31 of the current year)

Lot B - Senior Heifer Calf (Calved between September 1 and December 31 of the previous year)

Lot C - Summer Yearling Heifer (Calved between May 1 and August 31 of the previous year)

Lot D - Junior Yearling Heifer (Calved between January 1 and April 30 of the previous year)

Lot E - Spring Yearling Heifer (Calved between May 1 and August 31 of the previous year)

Lot F - Senior Yearling Heifer (Calved between September 1 and December 31, two previous year)

Lot G - Cow and Calf (Calf born after January 1 of the current year)
Bull calves must be less than six (6) months old. Show by class. No Grand
Champion awarded.

Lot H - Cow without Calf/Open Heifer (Born before August 31, two years previous)
Show by class. No Grand Champion awarded.

Class 2: Type Purebred - Females

Class 3: Type Crossbred - Females

Class 4: Type Beef Steers

Lot A - Heavy Feeder Steer (Over 850 lbs.)
