- Obedience Classes and Showmanship Class Champions and Reserve Champions will be based on highest score and judge's Discretion. Limit of two dogs per member (entries may be limited at Superintendent's discretion).

All members will be judged according to 4-H age groups:

Lots for classes 1-4

**Lot A – Junior**

**Lot B – Intermediate**

**Lot C – Senior**

**Lot D – Cloverbuds**

\* Cloverbud members can enter Showmanship, Tricks, but will not be judged.

**SHOWMANSHIP** - Leaders are encouraged to place highly qualified member in higher-level classes.

**Premium Points, Classes 1 - 3: Blue 75**

**Red 55**

**White 40**

**Class 1: Showmanship**

**INDIVIDUAL OBEDIENCE** - One dog may be entered one classes. If exhibiting two dogs, each dog may be entered in one (1) class each. Except as noted, each class is open to any exhibitor whose dog has not received a blue ribbon score in that class or higher at State Fair.

**Premium Points, Classes 2- 4: Blue 40**

**Red 30**

**White 22**

**Class 3: Beginner Novice**
