### **Class 1: Public Presentation**

- Members have the options of either submitting a video of your Demonstration/Illustrated talk or persuasive speech, or scheduling a Zoom live session for evaluation.
- Members must cite references, and why you chose this subject at the end of your Demonstration/Illustrated Talk or Persuasive Speech.
- Please dress appropriately for your presentations (neat, clean, hair combed, shirt tucked in).

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### **Class 2: Performing Arts**

**Premium Points, Class 2: 15 points per performance**

#### **Eligibility**

- Entries are open to all 4-H members, including Cloverbuds
- Entries must be made through FairEntry

### **Judging**

- Performing Arts is a non-judged activity, but feedback will be provided upon request
- Performers who successfully complete their performance will receive premium points

### **Performance Regulations**

- All performances, lyrics, costumes and behaviors must be 4H APPROPRIATE. If you aren't sure if your lyrics are acceptable, please send a copy of them to the email address above prior to submitting your recording.
- Please limit your recording length to 10 minutes. You may enter more than once if you need more time .

### **Performance Process**

- Create a video of yourself performing. It must be one continuous recording with no starts and stops.
  - Introduce yourself at the beginning of your video. Include such information as name, age, years of experience, club, other exhibits at the fair, etc.
  - Begin your performance. You may perform as many pieces as you can fit into your time slot. You may mix performance types (i.e. sing a song then play a song on an instrument.)
  - Before each piece announce the name of the piece and the composer.
- Upload your video link to Fair Entry when you enter the class

### **Exhibitor Conduct**

- Lyrics Code: Lyrics must not contain suggestive or inappropriate words or profane language.
- Dress Code: Appropriate attire to be worn at all times. Costumes including leotards, tights, short skirts or shorts are permitted if part of costume. Appropriate shoes for performances are required.

### **Class 3: 4-H in Action Premium Points, Class 3: 15 points per performance**

Lot A – 7-10 minute presentation of skills, knowledge or techniques learned this 4-H year.

### **Eligibility**

- Entries are open to all 4-H members, including Cloverbuds
- Entries must be made through FairEntry
- Entries should be uploaded into FairEntry as a file or link.
- This is a non-judged activity. It is not as formal as a demonstration, but should be planned and practiced.
- It is not necessary to pre-qualify for this activity.

- Participant is responsible for providing all supplies and equipment necessary to complete the activity.
  - Examples of activities that work well:
    - Spinning wool
    - Showing how to build something
    - Sharing how to make a craft item and let the public make an item to take home
    - Demonstrate how and why to recycle
    - Demonstrate Fitting and showing an animal
