Fleece must be from 4-H member's project. Fleece must have been shorn this year and must not represent more than one year's growth.

Each exhibitor may enter two fleeces.

Llama and Alpaca must be either brushed or picked (minimum weight of 4 oz.) or sheared blanket fleece 1 years growth (barrel of animal).
