

Asotin County 4-H/FFA Horse Project
Horse Owner Acknowledgment Certificate

If a 4-H/FFA member's immediate family does not own the horse they have registered as their 4-H/FFA project, the owner of the horse must review and sign a statement acknowledging the 4-H/FFA members' responsibilities.

Horse certificates #C0233 must be on file with the Extension Office 90 days before the Asotin County 4-H/FFA Horse. The 4-H/FFA member must be responsible for exercising and grooming the horse, even if it is boarded. Horses may not be with a professional trainer during this 90-day period.

This form should accompany horse certificate #C0233 that states that the horse is leased from a non-family member.
