We are needing 1 to 2 chaperones for this camp. This number could grow as there are 10 more slots for the event. The scholarship requested from Leaders Council was \$600 plus \$200 for van rental. This scholarship was approved.

The Bi-County Camp from June 17-21 will be held at Camp Wooten and we have 8 youth attending. The numbers are increasing on attendance from past years. The cost is \$175 per member and no scholarships have been requested.

New Business
