Record Book - These awards are based on a member's recordkeeping skills.

Project Achievement - These awards are based upon a member's participation in: record books, public presentations, judging contests, community service, fit/show or similar activity, and fair exhibit (type/riding class).

Clubs can choose to apply for awards, which will be evaluated based on the combination of the Club Secretary's Book and Program Planning Book.

Club Community Service - This award is evaluated based on: service projects, coordination with other organizations, and publicity of projects.

Club Membership Building - This award is evaluated based on: membership growth over the previous year, attendance at club meetings, projects of new members, participation in 4-H promotional activities, 4-H promotion in the community, and activity of new members.

Club Publicity - This award is evaluated based on: publicity outside of the club, publicity within the club, and the frequency of publicity.
