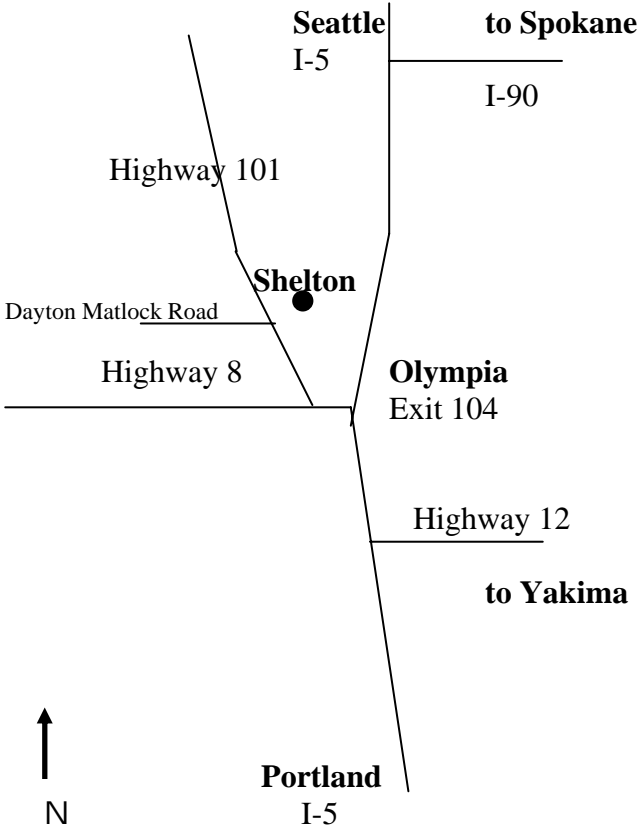


Directions to Panhandle Lake 4-H Camp
370 West Panhandle Lake Road, Shelton, WA 98584



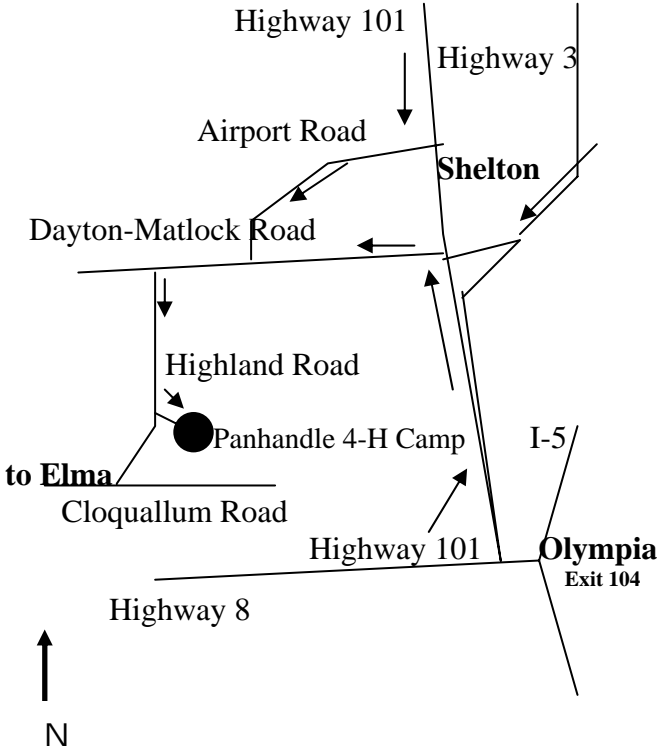
Northbound or southbound 1-5:

Follow I-5 to Olympia and take Exit 104 heading north and west. After about 5 miles, follow the Highway 101 exit toward Shelton. Stay on the divided highway, making sure you are in the left lane once you see a sign for Bremerton (Highway 3). About 2 miles after the divided highway becomes a two-lane road, take the exit for City Center & Dayton/Matlock Road. Keep to the left and make a left turn at the stop sign onto the Dayton-Matlock Road.

Southbound on Highway 101:

Turn right at the Dayton Airport Road sign, following it until it meets the Dayton-Matlock Road. Turn right and follow the remainder of the directions below.

Proceed on the Dayton-Matlock Road for 6 miles. About ¼ mile past the Dayton store, an arrow on a 4-H sign on the right directs you left onto Highland Road. After 4 miles on Highland Road, you will see a large sign on the left for Panhandle Lake 4-H Camp. Turn onto the driveway and proceed ¼ mile to the parking lot.



From Grays Harbor Co. Fairgrounds in Elma:

Proceed eastbound on the Elma-McCleary Road and take the first left past the fairgrounds, crossing the railroad tracks onto Cloquallum Road. Stay on this road for approximately 12 miles, continuing past Star Lake. Just past the Bucks Prairie store, turn left onto Highland Road. After 4 miles on Highland Road, you will see a large sign on the right for Panhandle Lake 4-H Camp. Turn onto the driveway and proceed ¼ mile to the parking lot.

Camper Supply List

You should bring:

1. Sleeping bag or bed roll, pillow, extra blanket, thick foam pad
2. Clothing for five FULL days, towels, wash cloths
3. Swimming suit
4. Jacket or heavy sweatshirt
5. Comfortable walking shoes. **NO sandals or open toed shoes**
(except for swimming and showering)
6. Toiletries: Soap, shampoo, toothbrush & toothpaste, deodorant, etc.
7. Flashlight and spare batteries

Optional Items:

- Rain Coat
- Bug Repellent and sunscreen
- Water bottle

Please Do Not Bring:

- Food, Cigarettes, Alcohol, Non-prescribed drugs
- Put downs or negative attitudes! ☺
- Things of value (I-Pods, Money, Cell Phones - We have a calling card for emergencies)
