

**EXCITING NEWS:**

4-H Members enrolled in Self-Determined Animal Science and the 4-H Pet Project, you will have the opportunity to exhibit your non-traditional 4-H project at the Grays Harbor County Fair in 2016.

An area is planned in the 4-H Exhibit Hall for these animals. You would be responsible for providing a safe and secure animal enclosure for your project, as well as for seeing to its daily care including feed provided at your expense.

Animals could be left in the building for the duration of the fair or could be taken home each evening after 8:00 pm and returned for exhibit the following morning by 9:45 am.

As with other exhibitors, you would be responsible for your own entry and parking passes.

Ribbons and fair premiums will be awarded per the Fair Exhibitor's Handbook in the Self-Determined Project, Division L, Section 1, Class 1. Animals are entered at your own risk. Please refer to the Exhibitor's Handbook for rules and guidelines at <http://extension.wsu.edu/graysharbor/4-h/links/> .
