The 4-H year pin is an award earned by the 4-H member for completing the 4-H year. As the Grays Harbor 4-H Leaders Council purchases these pins, the council has established guidelines for earning a year pin. The 4-H member must complete five of the following seven items to receive a pin:

1. Complete the project/projects in which the member is enrolled.
2. Attend at least 50% of their club's general and project meetings after enrollment.
3. Give a public presentation.
4. Complete the 4-H record book.
5. Exhibit at a fair or other designated activity.
6. Participate in a 4-H community project.
7. Serve as a club officer.

(Primary members are not required to complete items #3 and #4, but must complete four of the remaining five items.)
