To qualify for a buckle: Riders must participate in two Hairy Horse Shows to qualify. Points will be awarded to first to sixth place finishes with a minimum of two entries per class. Classes with fewer than two riders will not be eligible for buckle points. Points will be tallied on June 16 with buckles awarded after each section of performance and gaming. Showmanship does count towards points in each discipline.

OUR SHOW RULES ▼

When participating in the Washington State 4-H Youth Development Program, individuals must provide humane treatment and care to animals. Cruel or negligent treatment and handling will not be tolerated, and reported to show management

All Washington 4-H members and non-member youth (**UNDER 19**) participating in all equine projects and activities must wear (ASTM) and (SEI) approved headgear when riding or driving. **OVER 20** is not required to wear a helmet but is strongly encouraged to promote an example of proper safe riding attire and practice.

WSU Extension believes in the right of every child to a safe and supportive environment. Actions against children that lead or contribute to abuse or neglect are contrary to the values of 4-H. Such actions are inappropriate in any setting, especially where youth are concerned.

WSU Extension 4-H Youth Development Program Policy prohibits the possession, use, or distribution of illicit drugs, controlled substances, marijuana, marijuana products, electronic cigarettes, or alcohol at any 4-H related event involving youth. The WSU Extension 4-H Youth Development Program strictly enforces state of Washington laws regarding alcohol and does not tolerate the illegal use, possession, or sale of intoxicating beverages, minors in possession, furnishing alcohol to minors, possession of open containers, driving under the influence, and exhibiting unruly or intoxicated behavior. In addition, WSU Extension 4-H Youth Development Program does not permit any form of advertising of tobacco, marijuana, or spirit or beer products, including clothing, at any 4-H-related event involving youth.

Stallions older than 12 months are NOT allowed in 4-H contests or events.

Judges' decisions are final. And that's final!

Training equipment is optional

The PNW 4-H Horse Contest Guide and 4-H rules shall prevail in the event a decision is made and challenged.
