Boots and helmets are required. Judge's decision is final. Questions or concerns are to be brought to the show management not directed to the judge. Only working volunteers are allowed in the riding and showing area. There is to be no coaching during riding classes. Please let your riders prove they can do it on their own. 4-H promotes youth development. Adults are not allowed to assist 4-H riders except for safety reasons. Please ask the help of another 4-H member. The class announcements are a courtesy and the rider is responsible to be in their correct class on time. No cross entry. This means if you are entered in WALK/Trot classes you must stay in Walk/Trot classes all day. This applies to 1st year classes, Alternate classes, and regular classes. If you tie your horse to your horse trailer please clean up after it and fill in holes. There is to be NO RIDING ON THE PAVEMENT.
