## Meeting Minutes

- I. **CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by Brian Missildine, President.
- II. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** A motion was made to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded. The minutes as presented were passed unanimously.
- III. **TREASURER'S REPORT:** Information was not recorded by the Secretary.
- IV. **EXTENSION REPORT:** Tracie Hanson reported on the following:
  - a. GH 4-H Summer camp is on a waiting list at this time.
  - b. GH Fair resources are available online.
  - c. 4-H T-Shirt orders are due July 25.
  - d. There are fair still life entry forms available for completion prior to fair.
- V. **GENERAL COUNCIL:** The next 4-H General Council meeting will be held on July 23, 2018. It will be combined with the Fair Committee Meeting.
- VI. **FUN ACTIVITY:** The activity ball was passed around for the fun activity.
- VII. **HORSE SHOWS/CLINICS:**
  - a. Hairy Horse Show 3 ~ June 16:
    - Need to order one more buckle for high point
    - Would be best to have one person handle points, including high point, for next year. Reminder to put on agenda and horse show planning calendar for next year.
    - Drag needed to be set deeper.
  - b. Prefair ~ June 30 and July 1:
    - In discussing the proposed prefair ribbon-points change, it was noted that only blues, reds and whites carry over to fair. Grand and reserves count only as blue points.
    - There was discussion whether the grands and reserves should carry over to fair. There was a motion made by Gwen Carrell that prefair performance state qualifying classes may only carry over blues, reds and whites to fair. The motion was seconded by Denise Schupbach. It was then agreed to rescind the motion and table till October to discuss further.

### **VIII. COUNTY FAIR:**

- a. Entry forms were turned into Tracie Hanson for data entry.
- b. Volunteers: Gwen volunteered to do the volunteer work schedule and there was discussion regarding parents commenting that they do not volunteer and how to address as a leader. After discussion, it was suggested that a "time card" system of name of rider, date of show and time in/out be used to track volunteer hours.
- c. Gaming Judge: It was agreed that Charlene Gillaspie will be hired as a gaming judge. Ranie Creamer made a motion to compensate Charlene \$300 for fair judging. Denise Schupbach seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.
