VIRTUAL STILL LIFE ENTRIES AT THE STATE 4-H FAIR

The Washington State 4-H Fair Board is encouraging enrolled 4-H members in the junior, intermediate, and senior age divisions to submit virtual still life exhibits by Tuesday, September 1st. Project options include photos, gardening, expressive arts, foods, food preservation, STEM, educational displays and more! All entries must be emailed to the WA State 4-H Fair at st4hfair@wsu.edu with the entry form and the photos or pdf files described in the exhibitor guide. The Virtual Exhibit Guide and Entry Form is available on the State 4-H Fair website at https://extension.wsu.edu/4h/fairs/state-4-h-fair/ Since there is no prequalification needed for still life exhibits in the virtual classes, 4-H members simply need to enter projects that have been completed in the current 4-H year, after October 1st for projects that they are enrolled in.
