 - a. Phase 4
 - Dan . WSU is not allowing 4-H activities until the county reaches Phase 4
 - Potentially could enter Phase 4 around mid July
 - WSU has not yet put out a complete list of what the requirements will be but is expected to include face masks, gloves and physical distancing
 - Dan believes that we will be able to put together a modified horse show using those new guidelines
 - Gwen . would like to have signups in advance to allot a certain amount of time for each age/riding experience (i.e. 1st year riders, Juniors, Walk/Trot)
 - Days will be longer which will make it harder on volunteers
 - Will continue to be limited on how many members can show at one time
 - Issues could arise for families with numerous members with differing riding levels/age groups

 - Riders should be practicing riding with rubber gloves and face masks. No spectators, anyone in attendance will have to be volunteering
