Welcome to the new 4-H year and 4-H Online 2.0! All youth members and adult volunteers must log into 4-H Online and update their profiles in order to re-enroll for the new 4-H year. There is a new enrollment website, [v2.4honline.com](http://v2.4honline.com), and you will login using the same email and password that you used in the previous version. If you have forgotten your password just select the reset password option. Most of your information has transferred over however you will be prompted to add your club and projects.
