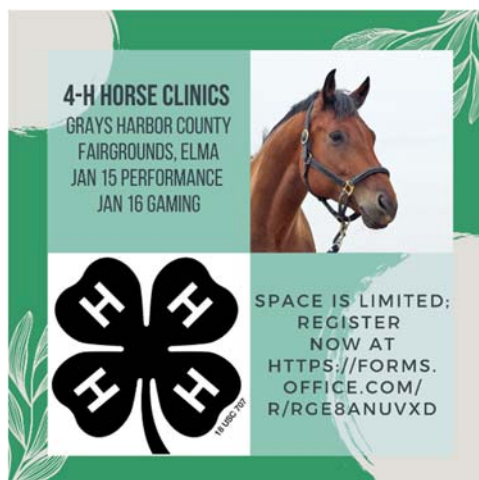
4-H SUMMER CAMP COUNSELOR TRAINING SERIES – Jan 15th

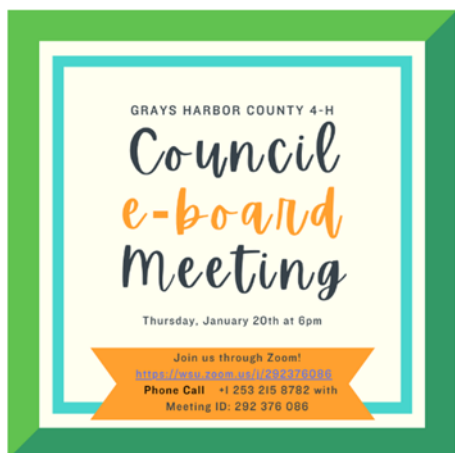

WSU 4-H SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS – January 1 – March 15
 Attention 12th grade 4-Hers! WSU 4-H Scholarship Applications will open on January 1, 2022. There are a variety of scholarships available! The deadline to apply is March 15, 2022.

Scholarships are available to all enrolled 12th grade 4-Hers who have accumulated at least 2 years of 4-H participation. An applicant must have an approved 4-H enrollment prior to application deadline.
