<u>A:</u> State Fair Decorations-We are still needing to purchase the magnets, poles, and clamps for the stall décor for State. She may paint with chalkboard paint for now and attach the names differently. Also, the knobs that we used originally are either not in stock or not on sale any longer, so we chose other ones from Amazon.

Rachel also started a discussion of having a rider bring more than one horse in a discipline and how that may look going forward.
