4-H Team Cake Decorating Challenge!

Inviting teams of 4-6 4-H members to participate in the first ever 4-H fair cake decorating challenge!!!!!!

- Open to all currently enrolled Grays Harbor/Mason County 4-H members regardless of in what project they're enrolled.
- Teams must sign up by Sunday, August 4th.
- Time of actual cake decorating will be flexible, depending on member schedules and kitchen availability. However, decorating must be completed by Saturday evening of fair (closing time).

The cake must be representative of the fair theme “How Country Feels” and must contain some reference to 4-H. All decorations on cake must be edible.

What will be provided to teams:

1. One 8” crumb-coated 2-layer cake on cake board.
2. Frosting (enough for final coat and decorative piping), and several containers for different colors.
3. Offset spatulas
4. Food coloring
5. Pastry bags & selection of tips
6. 8 oz. fondant or gum paste & 4oz. marzipan paste and a selection of tools (rolling pins, etc.)
7. Gloves, aprons, paper towels
8. Toothpicks

Teams will be allowed 90 min. to complete the decoration, and all team members must contribute to process.

What teams are allowed to bring (subject to inspection by contest official):

1. Edible flowers, fruits, berries, cookies, or nuts.
2. Cake stand made by member(s) of team.
3. Any hand tool or device other than what is provided to help in decoration process.

Cakes will be judged and prizes (yet to be determined) awarded using the following criteria:

1. Overall appearance (neatness & precision!)
2. Creative representation of member's idea of fair theme.
3. Aspect of 4-H clearly apparent.
4. Team work displayed during decorating time.

Cakes will be displayed during “Cowboy Breakfast” and will be available to purchase through a silent auction. Proceeds to benefit Grays Harbor/Mason Co. 4-H program.
