Most of these farms are small and family-owned, so supporting them is a great way to also support your local economy.

The Guide contains contact information for each business as well as short descriptions of what each business has to offer. Once you have reviewed the farms and what they offer in the guide, you can then consult the provided map and determine which farm is closest to you. Inside the Guide you will also find details for both the Shelton and Harstine Island Farmers Markets.
