### **REQUIREMENTS**

### Youth will

- 1. Earn a blue ribbon for a demonstration at either the club or county level.
  - a. Submit copy of 4-H Demonstration Evaluation
- 2. Earn a blue ribbon for their record book (either project or permanent)
- 3. Demonstrate leadership in 4-H
  - a. Write a one-page essay about the leadership roles that you have taken in 4-H
  - b. Answer the question, "How have you grown through 4H projects and clubs during the past year?"
  - c. Essays should be typed in 11 pt Calibri font with 1.5 spacing.
- 4. Serve the community
  - a. List hours served and projects undertaken
  - b. Write a paragraph answering the question, "What have you given back to 4-H & the community?"
  - c. Paragraph should be typed in 11 pt Calibri font with 1.5 spacing.
- 5. Earn 4 blue ribbons at the Pend Oreille County Fair
  - a. No more than two animal entries will be counted
  - b. Fair Categories for other projects will be used with no more than one project from each additional fair category.
