

# Pend Oreille County 4-H Virtual Showcase 2020 Class Procedures

**DEPARTMENT N: CAT – DIRECT QUESTIONS TO SUPERINTENDENT JESSICA SIMON 509-879-7355, [jessyinelk@yahoo.com](mailto:jessyinelk@yahoo.com)**

**General: Videos shall be performed with camera in the horizontal (landscape) position. Photos may be horizontal or vertical as best fits the subject matter. Complete an entry form with each emailed group of entries or with USB drive entries. Name the photo or video file with: Your exhibitor # - Class Number – and individual letter for each file. Example: if my exhibitor number is 356 and the class number is 5P and I have 4 photos for this entry, my files would be named: 356-5P-a, 356-5P-b, 356-5P-c, 356-5P-d. Please watch your videos all the way through before entering to ensure there are no errors in either the visual or audio.**

## **CLASS 1V: FITTING AND SHOWING MANDATORY (1 ENTRY)**

Complete a video with the following (show attire is recommended, but not required, long sleeves, pants and close-toed shoes are required for safety):

- Indicate your animal's name, breed, gender and age.
- Demonstrate how to remove the cat from the cage, carry it in safety hold, and then place it on the table.
- Complete the cat fitting & showing pattern per WSU publication EM4810E. Ensure the video is close enough to see the things you are demonstrating.
- What is your favorite thing about your animal?
- What do you feed your cat?
- Intermediate showmen shall also indicate (2) facts about cats and indicate (2) parts of the cat
- Senior showmen shall also indicate (3) uncommon facts about cats and indicate (5) parts of the cat.

## **CLASS 2V: CONFORMATION (UP TO 2 DISTINCT ENTRIES)**

Complete a video that shows all sides of the cat while standing it body type formation. Show the cleanliness of the cat's coat and show closeup of the inside of ears, legs, paws, eyes and teeth.

## **CLASS 3V: COSTUME (1 ENTRY)**

Complete a video with an introduction of your costume and showing all sides of the costume. If appropriate, show the costume with animal in motion.

## **CLASS 4V: BEST TRICK (1 ENTRY)**

Complete a video of your trick with a quick introduction. Be sure you include yourself and the cat in the frame so the judge can see the commands you use for the trick.
