



Clallam County 4-H Educational Displays

In addition to Educational Posters, 4-H members may also create Educational Displays in their project area(s). Educational Displays are judged in a different class than posters.

Posters and Displays: What is the Difference?

What is a 4-H Educational Display?

- Displays one main idea.
- A display necessitates more information than would be included on a poster.
- The exhibit may also be 3 dimensional, a scale model, actual product, notebook, etc.
- The educational display may be on poster board with a minimum of 3 posters.
- There are no size restrictions on educational displays.

What is a 4-H Educational Poster?

- The poster must be on 22" x 28" poster board. It may be horizontal or vertical.
- It may be done in any medium (watercolor, crayon, marker, ink, etc.).
- May attach objects to the poster to make it three dimensional.

To Exhibit a 4-H Educational Display in the Clallam County Fair:

- Displays must be turned in to your club leader before August 1st. Leaders must turn all Educational Displays in by 4:00pm to the Extension office on August 1st. Display judging is completed prior to fair.
- Can be a chart, graph, mobile, table display, tri-fold presentation board, or 3 dimensional display. Use your imagination.
- When using posters, exhibitor must have a minimum of 3 posters per enrolled project.
- Limit 2 displays per project.
- **No copyrighted illustrations or cartoons may be used.**
- Cannot be part of another entry such as a demonstration.
- Displays will be judged on the following criteria using [C0679 Educational Display Scorecard](#).
 - Design: Color, Lettering, Illustration, and Layout
 - Originality and Creativity: Imagination and Innovation
 - Educational Value: One main idea, effective message

To Exhibit a 4-H Educational Poster or Display at WA State 4-H Fair:

- Must have received a blue ribbon at county fair as a poster or display not as part of another entry such as a public presentation or county herdsmanship decoration.
- Fill out State Fair entry forms and leave Exhibits at the State Fair check-in the 4-H Still Life Building on Sunday afternoon of fair. Still life Exhibits will be delivered and entered in the WA State 4-H Fair by 4-H staff and returned to 4-H member after the state fair.
- Please request approval to enter large displays.
- Mark all items in a display with your county number.
