Clallam County 4-H Science and Arts (STEAM) Projects

ENROLLMENT:

1. Members must be enrolled in Science, Technology, Engineering or Creative and Performing Arts projects by **June 1st** for 4-H Fair participation.
2. Member enrolled in Science and Arts Projects can be in any age division.

RECORD BOOK:

Complete a 4-H Record Book with separate project record section for each project:

- Standard WSU Book: Use the journal.
- Clallam County 4-H Record Book: Use general project record.

COUNTY FAIR PARTICIPATION:

1. Qualifying members may participate in the 4-H Building at the Clallam County Fair and earn ribbons and premiums. Participation may include: Record Books, Educational Posters & Displays, 4-H in Action, Demonstrations, Club Displays and/or booths, and project equipment.
2. Members in Science and Arts projects may enter as many exhibits in their project area as allowed in the specific class information listed in the Exhibitor guide.
3. Performing Arts members are encouraged to participate in the 4-H Talent Show and give additional 4-H performances during the fair.
4. Members entering exhibits, activities or contests in the 4-H Building must participate in a minimum of 2 hours of herdsmanship duty to receive their fair exhibitor pass.
5. A completed certificate of flight form (C0994) is required for EACH rocket entered at County and State Fair.

AWARDS

STATE FAIR PARTICIPATION

1. Qualifying blue ribbon/In-project entries may be exhibited at the State 4-H fair. Entry forms and tags will be available on Sunday of Fair at the 4-H building. If possible, exhibits may be transported via mail by Extension office staff. Contact the 4-H building superintendent for more information.
