



Clallam County 4-H Leadership and Citizenship Projects

Enrollment

- ✿ Members are enrolled in Leadership, Service Learning, Citizenship, or any county wide or statewide 4-H projects by June 1st.
- ✿ Junior Leaders are Intermediates (Ages 11-13). Teen Leaders are Seniors (Ages 14- 18). All Intermediate and Senior members are encouraged to enroll in the Leadership project. Members enrolled in leadership projects are members who take a role in leading the group or other members. Adult Leaders should work with Jr. & Teen leaders to help them take responsibility within the club.
- ✿ Know Your Government (KYG) is a short term project that is meets at the county level. High school age members (grades 9-12th) may participate.
- ✿ State Wide projects include: 4-H Ambassadors, or the Wa St 4-H Teen Equity & Inclusion Task Force.
- ✿ Teens may be elected as representatives to the county 4-H council, State Fair Board, or State 4-H Advisory Board.

Record Book

Complete a 4-H Record Book with a project record section for each project including Know Your Government.

- ✿ Standard WSU Book: Use the journal.
- ✿ Clallam County 4-H Record Book: Use general project record.

County Fair Participation

- ✿ Qualifying members may participate in the 4-H Building at the Clallam County Fair and earn ribbons and premiums. Participation may include: Record Books, Educational Posters & Displays, 4-H in Action, Demonstrations, Club Displays and/or booths, and project equipment.
- ✿ Members entering activities or contests in the 4-H Building must participate in a minimum of 2 hours of herdsmanship duty to receive their fair exhibitor pass.
