Interested in Starting a 4-H Club?

- * 4-H is open to all youth from 5—not yet 19 years of age as of Oct 1st of current 4-H year.
- * Large animals and shooting sports require that the youth be at least 8 years of age as of Oct 1st.
- * The 4-H year runs from Oct 1st—Sept 30th.
- * Youth are separated by age categories as follows:
 - * Cloverbuds: 5-7 years old Junior: 8-10 years old Intermediate: 11-13 years old Seniors: 14-19 years old

Adult Volunteer Requirements

Requirements to become a certified volunteer are:

- * complete a Volunteer Application and return completed reference forms,
- pass a criminal background check and renew background check every three years,
- watch training videos on extension.org and submit to certificate of completion to extension office,
- * attend in-person (or zoom) training,
- * create a profile on 4-HOnline and re-enroll every year before meeting with youth.
- * Show proof of COVID-19 vaccination to 4-H Program Coordinator or obtain an approved exemption from WSU.
- * Adults must log their volunteer hours.
- * Adults are only considered Certified Volunteers when they have an active, approved enrollment in 4-H Online.

Club Charter Requirements

All clubs must have the following:

- * General club leader needs to complete club leader training. Treasurer needs to complete treasurer training on extension.org.
- * 5 youth from at least 3 families.
- * Clubs hold a minimum of 6 business meetings throughout the year.
- * Clubs have youth officers.
- * You must have at least 2 certified adult volunteer/leader.
- Current ANNUAL membership dues: \$25 per youth (state fee) and \$5 per youth with a 3 youth family cap (county fee).
 - * Clubs may have additional costs.
- Scholarships are available upon request. Please contact county 4-H Program Coordinator: Melanie Greer.

County Requirements:

To "complete" a 4-H year, you are required to:

- complete a Record Book (Cloverbuds do not have this requirement),
- * attend at least 2/3 of general club meetings unless excused by club leader,
- * complete at least one club level public presentation (demonstration),
- * complete any additional club requirements (for example community service),
- * Meet any project specific requirements and entry requirements for each barn at the Clallam County Fair.

Club Requirements:

- * Clubs follow all state and county policies and can enact additional polices and/or Club Agreements.
- Club members, adult and youth, follow any club agreements.
