4-H Year Completion

Complete your 2021-2022 4-H year by finishing your 4-H record books and turning them in to your club leader by the end of September. This is how you earn your year-end pin and become eligible for county awards. Record books and award applications are due to the 4-H office by Monday, October 3rd.

Clallam County Fair Junior Royalty

Junior Royalty is for youth in 3rd through 8th grades. Any Clallam County 4-H member can apply EACH year even if they have already been junior royalty, with writing a NEW essay each year of application. THE NEW DEADLINE IS OCTOBER 1st.
