It's that time of year again! Remember to Re-enroll!

Welcome to a new year of 4-H! We are looking forward to another great year of 4-H positive youth development. Re-enrollment is open now!

Please remember that all youth and volunteers need to re-enroll on [4-H Online](#). We have a video on how to use 4-H online available on [You Tube here](#).



The youth fee for the year is \$35. This is a combination of the \$10 county fee and the \$25 state fee. If you wish to pay the full amount by credit card you can do so when you re-enroll on 4-H Online. If you wish to pay by check or cash, or if you need a scholarship please submit [this form](#) with your payment. No youth is ever denied a scholarship.

Remember that clubs cannot meet until the leader is re-enrolled and youth members are unable to fully participate until they are fully enrolled for the year.

Cash and check payments can be submitted to the County Extension office and checks should be made payable to 'Washington State University 4-H'.

The office will begin approving new year enrollments in the next week or so. We are waiting on word from the state on volunteer vaccination requirements for the new year.

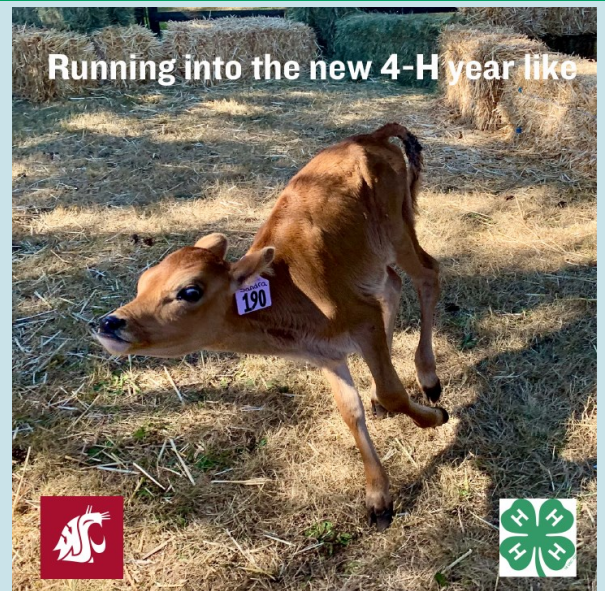
