

4-H JUNIOR ROYALTY APPLICATION DEADLINE OCTOBER 1 GRADES 3,4,5,6,7,8

Dear Participant,

The Clallam County Fair 4-H Junior Royalty is open to any 4-H Club member in Clallam County in grades 3,4,5,6,7,8. You must be an active and an enrolled 4-H Member in Clallam County to apply. 4-H members can apply each year of each new school grade but a **NEW** essay will be required for each new school year.

A one page, typed essay entitled "My 4-H Life and What It Means To Me" needs to be sent along with your name, address, phone number, email address, age, name of school, names of parents or guardians and name of 4-H club, project or projects and years in 4-H, are required in essay. Essay needs to be turned in by **OCTOBER 1**. You will be notified if your essay meets the requirements. 4-H Jr. Royalty will be announced at 4-H Celebration (Achievement Day) which is held on the first Sunday in November. A tiara and sash will be awarded to girls and a sash awarded to boy.

Requirements other than essay- A completed record book turned in October 1. We would like junior royalty to attend the Sequim Irrigation Festival Parade in May and Port Angeles 4th of July Parade is another opportunity. Fair opportunities will be talked about later.

Parents/guardians will be responsible for getting 4-H junior royalty member to and from each function and will be responsible if any expense occurs. Parents or responsible adults must remain with 4-H Junior Royalty members during events and at fair. 4-H Junior Royalty at fair cannot be unchaperoned while wearing their sash or tiara. Junior Royalty DOES NOT do the same things as Senior Royalty at fair.

RULES FOR CLALLAM COUNTY FAIR JUNIOR ROYALTY

1. Use of illicit drugs/chemicals, tobacco, and/or alcohol, will be grounds for immediate dismissal.
2. Courtesy, respect, and consideration to everyone will be always of primary importance. The court members are expected to conduct themselves in a way befitting the Fair royalty, to be well groomed, gracious, and courteous always. Good sportsmanship will always be expected. Improper behavior or physical and emotional threats will not be tolerated and are grounds for dismissal. Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
3. The Royalty Committee will set clothing guidelines for all events. Junior Royalty will **NOT** wear tiara on hat as Senior Royalty does. Nice jeans and a nice shirt and comfortable walking shoes are acceptable for attire.
4. It is the Royalty Committee's decision to terminate royalty who does not follow the established Rules and Guidelines.
