Everyone must show in at least one showmanship class on Saturday to show Friday, Saturday, or Sunday. Classes count for State points except for pleasure classes.

Sunday: Western & Trail ... 9:00am

Age divisions: • Junior: 8 to 10 years of age • Intermediate: 11 to 13 years of age • Senior: 14 to less than 19 years of age (Age as of October 1, 2022)

No cross entry between Age Division classes, Maiden classes, and Walk/Jog classes
You may only enter Walk/Jog your first and second year <u>before</u> showing in lope classes
Maidens are never to have won a blue ribbon in that event
Walk/Trot and Maiden divisions not eligible to qualify for State Fair
Pleasure Champions will be awarded in classes this weekend... Equitation Champions are not awarded until Fair classes.
Equitation classes are judged on the rider's performance - Pleasure classes are judged on the horse's performance

4H & Fair rules apply...including helmets required.

Judged by the Danish system. - Participants must be currently enrolled 4H or FFA members.

All youth under 18 years of age must have a designated adult chaperone present, including overnight.



NRHA Reining Pattern 2

Beginner class may use two hands and perform simple lead changes

Advanced class must use one hand with a shank bit (unless riding a junior horse) and flying lead changes score higher



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

- **1.** Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- **2.** Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- **3.** Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- **4.** Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
- **5.** Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
- **6.** Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- **7.** Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.
