*Equitation classes are judged on the rider's performance - Pleasure classes are judged on the horse's performance*

### Clallam County Fairgrounds Camping Rules & Regulations

1. **There must be an adult staying in each campsite.**
2. Use or possession of intoxicants, narcotics, illegal drugs, or use of vulgarity is prohibited on the grounds and camping area. Any campers using loud or profane language will be dismissed from the Fairgrounds. General Rules of the Fair apply.
3. Enforced quiet hours are from 10pm-8am. Generators must be turned off during quiet hours. Please advise everyone in the campsite of the quiet hour requirements.
4. No campfires are allowed on the Fairgrounds.
5. All pets must remain on a leash.
6. **Please remember to clean up your campsite area and stalls before you leave.**

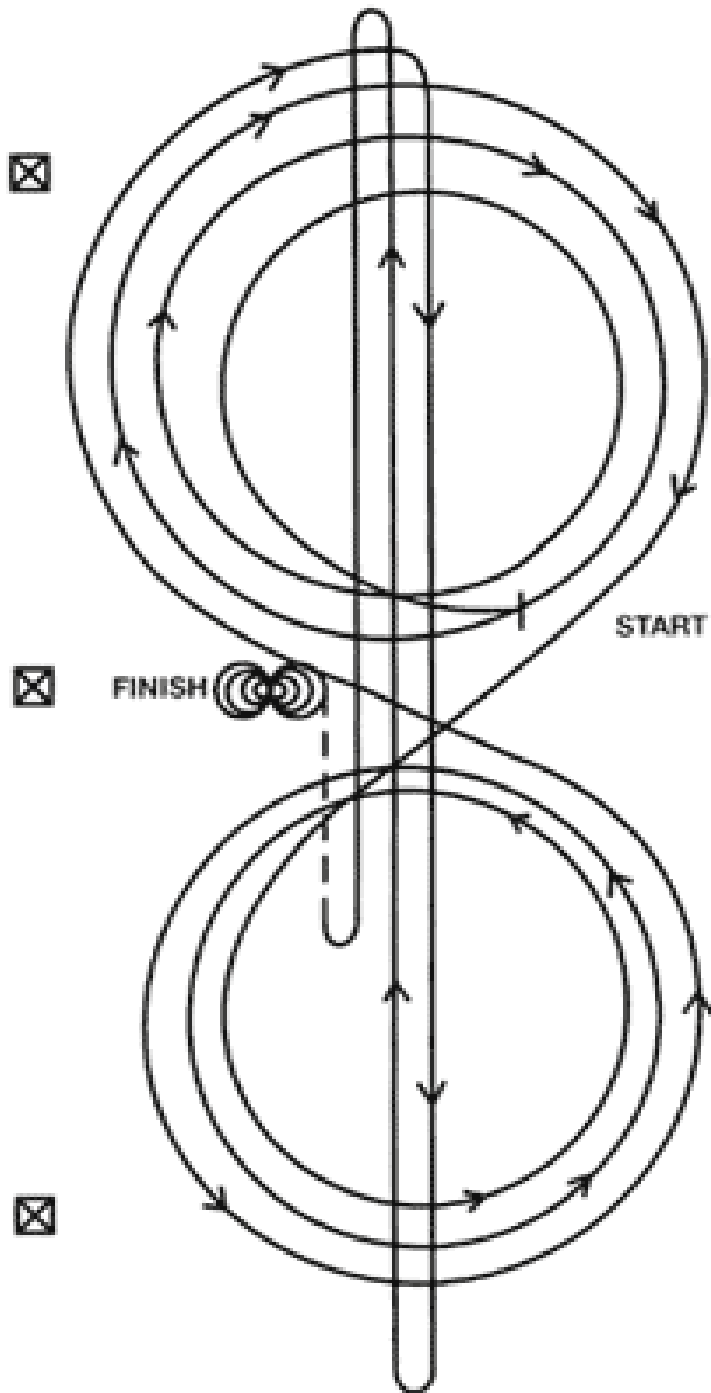

# NRHA Reining Pattern 2

Beginner class may use two hands and perform simple lead changes

Advanced class must use one hand with a shank bit (unless riding a junior horse) and flying lead changes score higher



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.

5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.

6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.
