


WHEN IN DOUBT SEW IT OUT!

During this activity hour we will be making square hot pad with a pocket. Instruction will be given through zoom. This sewing project will make a great addition to your kitchen!

Supplies needed:

- ¼ -yard fabric (enough for 2 8" x 8" squares and 2 8" x 5 1/3" rectangles; fabric can be from old projects, discount squares or old cotton shirts)
- ¼ -yard Insul-fleece/Insul-bright or similar product (enough for 2 8" x 8" squares and 1 8" x 5 1/3" rectangle)
- 1 ½ yards of ½ -inch double fold Bias Tape
- Sewing machine or sewing needle
- Thread
- Scissors
- Piece of paper
- Cup
- Ruler
- Pen
- Pins



Thursday August 6th at 1:00pm – 2:00pm

During this activity we will be making fabric coasters. Instruction will be given through zoom. This project is fun because you can use extras that were left over from other projects. These coasters will add a personal touch to your home!

Supplies needed:

- Scissors
- Pins or clips
- Sewing machine or sewing needle
- Ruler
- Iron
- Batting, interfacing, fleece, or terry cloth
- Fabric (this can be scraps from other projects or discount squares at the store; it is suggested to have 2 prints so they can be reversible, but you can also have more if you want them to all be different; it is suggested to have enough to make a set of 4 coasters but that is up to you for how many is in the set; 2 squares are needed for each coaster that are 5 ½ inches but they can be small like 4 ½ inches if that is what your fabric allows)
