<p>AMERICAN ORIGINAL BEEFSTEAK</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 65 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>Heirloom look and feel. Large beefsteak fruits that benefit from breeding to hold their texture and flavor longer after picking. Packed with exactly the right amount of flavor for fresh eating in salads and sandwiches.</p>
<p>BEEFSTEAK</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Open Pollinated 80 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>Large, solid, meaty, juicy, brilliantly red fruits weigh up to 2 lbs. An excellent slicer, with a rich, sub-acid flavor.</p>

<p>CELEBRITY</p> 	<p>Semi-Determinate Hybrid 70 Days to Maturity Disease resistant Crack resistant</p>	<p>A great, all-round, dependable choice for your "basic" tomato needs -- sandwiches, slicing, snacks, and bruschetta. The large tomatoes are prized for their flavor.</p>
<p>CRIMSON CARMELLO</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 75 days to Maturity LB, TMV, N, V</p>	<p>Produces heavy clusters of round fruit on strong, uniform plants. Especially impressive is its generous size fruit and well-developed flavor for such an early hybrid tomato.</p>

<p>EARLY GIRL</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 57 Days to Maturity F 1-2, V</p>	<p>Early season. Meaty, ripe, red fruits, 4 to 6 oz. Firm texture and blemish-resistant skin. Heavy yields on hardy vines.</p>
<p>FANTASTIC</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 80 Days Disease resistant Crack Resistant</p>	<p>Tasty, globe-shaped, scarlet red, 3 to 5", medium-sized fruits are almost crack-free. Rich in beefsteak flavor. Heavy yields are excellent for canning. Medium size</p>
<p>LEGEND</p> 	<p>Determinate Open Pollinated 68 Days to Maturity Disease resistant LB</p>	<p>One of the earliest maturing slicing tomatoes. The big, 4-5 inch, parthenocarpic fruit are glossy red, with a uniform round shape. Cold tolerant.</p>
<p>MOUNTAIN MERIT</p> 	<p>Determinate Hybrid 75 Days to Maturity F 1-3, LB TSWV, V IR AB, N. Crack resistant.</p>	<p>2014 AAS Winner. Medium to large, 8 to 10 ounce deep red fruits with excellent resistance to Late Blight, as well as others, makes the perfect slicing tomato.</p>
<p>OREGON SPRING</p> 	<p>Determinate Open Pollinated 60 Days to Maturity V resistant</p>	<p>Early variety that sets loads of meaty fruits weighing 3 to 5 oz., with excellent flavor. Compact plants set fruits even in cool weather and continue to yield all season long. Nearly seedless. A perfect choice for ketchup and sauces.</p>
<p>SILETZ</p> 	<p>Determinate Parthenocarpic 60 days. F1, V</p>	<p>Siletz is one of the most reliable slicing tomatoes you can grow. The flavor-packed red tomatoes are nearly seedless. Expect several bursts of ripe tomatoes as the season progresses.</p>
