

HEIRLOOM TOMATOES

<p>BLACK KRIM</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Heirloom, Beefsteak 75 days</p>	<p>Dark reddish-purple to black with green/brown shoulders. It's pretty early, very prolific, and the flavor just can't be beat.</p>
<p>BLACK SEA MAN</p> 	<p>Determinate Heirloom 75 days</p>	<p>A hardy Russian heirloom. Rich, tangy tomato flavor in medium-sized, 4 to 8 oz. fruits with brown-black skins and pink shoulders.</p>
<p>Black vernissage</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Heirloom 75 days</p>	<p>Here is a lovely "black" tomato that is loaded with flavor as well as production. This 2 oz. tomato is perfect for rich tasting sauces.</p>
<p>BONNY BEST</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Heirloom 80 days</p>	<p>Bright red fruits average about five ounces, and deliver a mildly tart flavor that one would expect from a classic red tomato.</p>
<p>BRANDYWINE RED</p> 	<p>Indeterminate 80 days Disease tolerant, Crack tolerant</p>	<p>Brandywine is one of the best known heirloom tomato varieties. Fruits are red and full of flavor. Very vigorous. Perfect for slicing.</p>
<p>CHEROKEE PURPLE</p> 	<p>NW Experts Pick Indeterminate 75-80 days</p>	<p>A dusky-rose heirloom with a history dating from before the 1890s. Medium sized; pink-purple with brownish color.</p>
<p>COSMONAUT VOLKOV</p> 	<p>Determinate Heirloom 72 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>From the Ukraine. Rich, deep, balanced, sweet and tangy flavor. 2-3 inch, deep orange/red fruit with green tinged shoulders and bright red interiors.</p>
<p>CUORE DI BUE</p> 	<p>Indeterminate 85 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>This Italian heirloom, a huge, pink Oxheart type. Abundant, 4" fruits on vigorous plants are a colorful pinkish-red with a sweet flavor.</p>
<p>CUOR DI ALBENGA</p> 	<p>Indeterminate 85 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>This Italian heirloom is known as a triple-purpose tomato because it is great fresh, canned, or made into sauce. It produces nice pear-shaped fruit, and it is moderately disease resistant.</p>
<p>DELICIOUS</p> 	<p>Indeterminate - 77 days to harvest Hybrid Resists cracking</p>	<p>A refined selection of beefsteak; Excellent slicer. Smooth solid fruits seldom crack and have excellent flavor.</p>
<p>GENUWINE</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Marriage Heirloom 70-75 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>Genuwine has the heirloom look and flavor but the vigor and crack resistance of a hybrid. A cross between Costoluto Genovese and Brandywine. Average in size is 8-12 ounces.</p>
<p>GLACIER</p> 	<p>Determinate 55 days.</p>	<p>This very early tomato variety produces attractive orangey-red 2 ½ inch tomatoes.</p>
<p>GREEN ZEBRA</p> 	<p>Indeterminate 75 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>Green Zebra's sweet and zesty flavor is as appetizing as its appearance is spectacular. The 1 1/2 - 2 1/2 inch fruit have glowing green skin overlaid with olive and gold mottled streaks.</p>

JAPANESE TRIFELE BLACK 	Indeterminate 85 Days to Maturity	Heavy producer of pear-shaped 3 to 5-ounce fruits. Intense black to dark grey blushed with magenta. Potato leaf plants. An excellent canner as it holds its flavor and color well.
JUANE FLAMME 	Indeterminate 75 Days to Maturity	This was one of the favorites of the 2008 Carmel TomatoFest tomato tasting. A good choice for cooking, eating fresh or canning
MANITOBA 	Determinate 66 Days to Maturity F 1, V. Container	Fruits are bright red, good-flavored, and weigh about 6 oz. each. Easily grown in a small area. Great for slicing or for canning. One of the more productive early heirlooms.
MARGLOBE 	Determinate 73 Days to Maturity Good disease resistance	This old variety was released by USDA in 1925 and has heavy, vigorous vines that produce high yields of large (8-10 oz.), uniform, globe-shaped fruit.
MOONGLOW 	Indeterminate Open Pollinated 80 Days to Maturity	Medium-sized, bright orange fruits glow with neon intensity against 36" vines. A high yielder and good keeper, 3 to 4 oz., globe shaped fruits that are dense and meaty, with thick walls and few seeds.
MR. STRIPEY 	Indeterminate 80 Days to Maturity	Huge crops of red fruits with clearly defined yellow-orange stripes. 1-1/2 to 2 inch tomatoes have a rich, tangy flavor and are a beautiful novelty for adding whole or cutting into salads.
STUPICE 	Indeterminate 52 Days	A native of Czechoslovakia, where its extreme earliness, tolerance to cold, superior flavor and high yields have earned it worldwide attention. Very abundant and sweet, weighing 1 to 2 oz.
SURENDER'S INDIAN CURRY 	Determinate 70 Days to Maturity	Short, compact plants that yield 2", red fruit that is juicy and more acidic than sweet for Indian curries. A very good choice for a patio garden or small garden or hanging basket.
TAXI 	Determinate 70 Days to Maturity	The best yellow variety for short season areas. Bright yellow 4 to 6 oz. fruits. Excellent fresh for salads, sandwiches.
TAZMANIAN CHOCOLATE 	Dwarf- Determinate 70 Days to Maturity Container	Large 8 to 12 ounce, beefsteak type fruits Short, sturdy vines offer beautiful, plump mahogany red/orange, faintly striped tomatoes with delicious, well-balanced flavor. Great for pots and small spaces.
WOODLE ORANGE 	Indeterminate 70-80 days to harvest Large size	Large, round, smooth fruit. Brilliant tangerine color. Incredible rich and sweet complex flavor
