








PLUM TOMATOES

<p>FIASCETTO DI MANDURIA</p> 	<p>Determinate 65-70 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>Pronounced "Fee-ah-SKET-oh" These 2-3 oz. plum tomatoes with a slight point on the blossom end are great for juicing, sauce, or fresh eating. They are also wonderful sun-dried (or oven-dried).</p>
<p>LaRoma 3</p> 	<p>Determinate Hybrid 76 Days to Maturity Disease resistant VFFNASt</p>	<p>An excellent roma tomato known for its vigor and uniformity. Bright red, meaty fruits are large, 5 to 8 ounces, and full of flavor. Disease resistant plants are very vigorous and produce fruit abundantly throughout the growing season. The perfect variety for any home gardener who enjoys canning or making their own pastes and sauces.</p>
<p>Martino's Roma</p> 	<p>Dwarf-determinate Heirloom 75 days</p>	<p>Richly flavored, meaty, pear-shaped fruits set heavily on compact plants with rugose, dark green foliage. So heavily productive, the 2 oz., 3" fruits tend to drop from the vine when ripe. Most often used for cooking, but perfectly suited to eating fresh.</p>
<p>Principe Borghese</p> 	<p>Determinate Heirloom 75 Days</p>	<p>An excellent heirloom grape tomato revered for its drying qualities and use in sauces. This determinate variety, originally from Tuscany, has fruits with few seeds and a relatively dry meat, perfect for paste</p>
<p>Roma</p> 	<p>Determinate Open Pollinated 75 Days VFNA LB</p>	<p>Roma is considered to be the most well-known paste-type tomato, perfect for sauces, pastes and ketchup. Its heavy crops of bright red, pear-shaped fruits are nice and meaty, with very few seeds.</p>
<p>San Marzano</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Open Pollinated 80 Days</p>	<p>One of the richest roma types. Superb flavor in slightly rectangular-shaped fruits, 3-1/2" x 1-1/2" that are bright red and hang in large clusters. Holds well on the vine and in storage. High in sugars, pectin, and flavor for the very best in sauces, pastes, and soups</p>
<p>Yellow Pear</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Open Pollinated 78 Days VFA LB</p>	<p>Vigorous vines produce high yields of 2", yellow-skinned, pear-shaped fruits with few seeds. Dependable performance.</p>
