4-H Age Divisions-What's New: Reminder that the WA State Policy has been updated. 4-H age divisions are now based on AGE by October 1st of the current 4-H year. Also, our "Primary" members have a new name..... Cloverbuds. These changes were made to align our state with National 4-H standards. NOTE: Some youth will change age divisions as a result of this update.

- Clover buds: 5 to 7 years of age
- Junior: 8 to 10 years of age (Youth must be Juniors or above to participate in Shooting Sports projects, large animal projects, and the Junior Livestock Auction)
- Intermediate: 11 to 13 years of age
- Senior: 14 to less than 19 years of age

If youth status says “PENDING” it means that we are still waiting on your membership fees. Membership fees are \$25 per youth, \$20 to WSU 4-H and \$5 to Kitsap County 4-H Council. Payment can be mailed or hand delivered to the office. Members must have an “ACTIVE” status in 4-HOnline to be covered by 4-H’s insurance and participate.
