Committee and Project Reports

Awards- The forms have been changed and will be put online shortly. Tim Schwartz is planning to attend the August Council meeting to explain the changes and answer any questions.

Audit- The audit has been rescheduled.

Camp Program- Camp had 36 campers, 17 teen counselors and 18 adults in attendance. Panhandle is not going to be available for use next July and the camp is increasing their fees. There's a camp board meeting 7/17 to decide if we'll be able to use the facility. An after camp review party will be held 7/12 at 6:30 PM.

Fundraising- Kay Hibler's Pie Fundraiser sold 127 pies. About \$400 was raised to go to the 4-H Family Fund. A motion was made by Mike Vogel and seconded by Wanda Meeker to send a condolence card to the Oas family. The motion passed. Mention was made of a donation to the Cystic Fibrosis foundation in lieu of sending the family flowers but Joy wanted to look into the rules regarding the Council sending money to another non-profit.

Market Auction- Fair entries are due 7/15 at the Eagle's Nest for Open Class and the 4-H Office for our youth.

Rabbit/Cavy- The Rabbit and Cavy kids will have a Mini Fair to help prepare the kids for fair. They will be able to practice all of the contests fair will have. The Archery kids have been invited to join in on the fun.

Record Books- Books are due 8/18 at the Fairgrounds. Judges are needed to help judge them before fair starts.

Shooting- The last meeting before fair will be 7/15. Anything that needs to be done before fair will be finished up.

Old Business

The 4-H tractor that's been stored at Shannon Harkness' house will be moved to Mike Vogel's property 7/6. He's hoping to find help in repairing it so that it can be used by 4-H again.

Chuck Endicott is working on changes to the By-Laws and is hoping to present them to the Council in September.

New Business

Nanette Seevers moved to approve up to \$125 to provide food and drinks for those judging posters and record books. Katie Matteson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Debbie McKeever moved to allow the Secretary of the Council to purchase a book of stamps to be used for sending out cards and letters for our 4-H families. Chuck Endicott seconded. The motion passed.

Ken Kramer has decided to add a cash prize in addition to rosettes for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in the display contest honoring 100 years of 4-H. 1st will receive \$75, 2nd gets \$50 and 3rd gets \$25.
