Required parts of this application:

- 1. ENTRY FORM FOR SPONSORED AWARDS
- **2. Be sure to put a checkmark to the right** of each award the member is nominated for and/or is applying for.
- **3. Print the specific award forms** and fill them out (found on county 4-H website). Be sure to include contact information on each form so invitations to Recognition Night can be mailed to award recipients.
- 4. Staple the Entry Form on top of all the awards.
- **5.** All forms go in the front left pocket of the member's record book.

Members may apply for as many of the SPONSORED AWARDS as they qualify for. Make sure the member's record book has details to support achievements during the most recent 4-H year.

Leaders are not limited to how many awards they may nominate a member for from the list of SPONSORED AWARDS.

Record books do not have to be updated after August for members to be eligible for year-end awards; however, having entries through September 30 may be advantageous for the member when awards are judged. All record books that are entered for the best record books in Kitsap County should have entries through September 30 in all project tabs.

All materials must be submitted to the Extension Office by the Kitsap County award application due date which is usually the second Tuesday in October. The exception is years when October 1 falls on a Wednesday or Thursday; then the due date will be the first Tuesday in October. Check the Kitsap County 4-H newsletter for the exact date.
