2. Members must turn in a 4-H Awards Entry Form and this application form by the county due date. Submitting a completed 4-H record book for year-end judging is optional, but highly recommended in order to receive the best possible score.
3. Members must present a demonstration, illustrated talk or speech related to gardening in front of a community group, school, other 4-H club, or at the county competition in the year of the application.
4. Member must have exhibited in the Plant Science Project at Kitsap County Fair in the year of the application.
5. Member must have participated in the Judging Contest at Kitsap County Fair in the year of the application.
6. Extra points awarded to members who have done community service, exhibited a poster on Plant Science, and exhibited in open class Flora/Horticulture at Kitsap County Fair in the year of the application.
