

Lincoln County 4-H Livestock Judging Contest Policy

- I. Judging Contests – State Fair Qualifications
 - A. To qualify for the Lincoln County Livestock Judging Team and participate in the Washington State 4-H Fair, intermediate and senior 4-H members must:
 1. Judge at a minimum of any two contests through out the year (August of previous 4-H year to July of current 4-H year) and the contests must consist of (minimum)
 - a. One class each of beef, sheep and swine.
 - b. One of the contests must also require oral reasons.
 - B. Results of the contests attended must be turned in to the WSU Extension Livestock Agent (Davenport office) by July 15 in order to be considered for State Fair qualification.
 1. **It is the responsibility of the 4-H Leader to submit the scores to the extension office.**
