Directions!

Once you arrive in Chewelah turn east at the stoplight. This puts you on e Main Street (note: the stoplight is at the intersection of Highway 395 and Main Street) Some street signs will read Main Ave instead of Main Street. **Travel east on Main Street. Once you go through some gentle curves you will be on Flowery Trail Road. Follow this road for approximately 8 miles.** When you reach the summit you will see two roads on the left that go the homeowner's' area; our driveway is just beyond theirs on the left as you head down the hill. There is a small sign at the road the reads **CHEWELAH PEAK LEARNING CENTER** and you will see a snow park-parking loop on the right when you reach our driveway on the left.
