- 4-H #29, Lincoln-Adams Scholarship **Form**
- Copy of Permanent 4-H **Record AND/OR** detailed **history-log** of activities in 4-H, school & community
 - Include list of organizations, events & activities in which you participated during the past four years
 - Detailed log reflecting a recommended total of 75 hours of 4-H and non-4-H Community service (minimum of 60 hrs. needed to qualify), with **time spent for each activity** listed
- Two-page **4-H Story** (Introduce yourself, and describe your 4-H experience including how 4-H has affected your personal development and prepared you for your future)
- Two letters of **recommendation** - one must be from a high school teacher, counselor, principal, or 4-H leader (other than an immediate family member)

*This application is **ONLY** for scholarships administered by the Lincoln-Adams 4-H Scholarship Committee. 4-H'ers are encouraged to ALSO apply for WA State 4-H Scholarships which have a different application procedure.

Note to recipients: The scholarship monies are granted in the name of each recipient to his/her educational institution's registrar's office upon second quarter/semester enrollment. **It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to provide registrar contact information to their 4-H Leaders' Council Treasurer.**
