

Enrollment and WA State 4-H Membership Fee Invoice Instructions for the 2018-2019 4-H Year

For youth members whose PRIMARY Club is in LINCOLN County, WA.

NEW 4-H members (adult leaders or youth) who are **sure they do NOT have another family member in the 4hOnline Enrollment System** should login to <https://wa.4honline.com> and set up a new profile. Contact the Extension Office if you aren't sure whether you already have a profile before proceeding.

This "[NEW Families Help Guide](#)" has instructions for setting up a family and individual profile or adding another family member to an existing profile. Firefox, Chrome, or Safari browsers work best.

Returning 4-H members (adult leaders or youth) – or **new members of families already in the system** should login to <https://wa.4honline.com> using the primary household email from last year and your password. If you don't remember your email, or if it has changed, contact Karen at robertk@wsu.edu before proceeding. If you don't remember your password, use the "I forgot my password" option.

After updating or completing the *Personal Information, Additional Information, Health Form, and Participation* sections in [4hOnline](#), you will "Continue" to the "**Invoice Section.**"

The Lincoln Co. 4-H Leaders' Council has committed to covering the \$25 WA State 4-H Enrollment fee for all new youth members and those re-enrolling in the following clubs/groups.*

Almira 4-H, Davenport 4-H Club, Odessa Jr. Livestock, Pasture Pals II 4-H Club, Reardan Livestock, Sprague Lamont 4-H, and Bageant Family 4-H.

- Ignore Purple "Scholarship Selection" – Does not apply to WA State 4-H
- You will see an invoice for the WA State 4-H Enrollment Fee
- Click "Continue" at the bottom of page
- On the "**Payment**" page
 - If member enrollment fees for your **PRIMARY club or Family 4-H Group will be covered by the Lincoln Co. 4-H Leaders' Council Lincoln County**, click the ☺ button next to the "County/Club 4H Check in the "Payment Section."
(The Lincoln Co. 4-H Leaders' Council will submit a check covering your fee.)*
Then "continue"
 - If you will be paying your own WA State 4-H Enrollment fee you can choose either the Card Payment Method OR the Check Payment Method.
 - For Card Payment – be sure and wait at least 15 seconds before advancing to the next page after "saving" in the "Payment" section. Otherwise, your CC/debit card info may not actually be entered into the system.
 - If paying by check:
 - Make the check out to "**Washington State University 4-H**" and mail with this "[Check Enclosure Form](#)" to: WSU Lincoln-Adams 4-H Program, 205 W Main Ave, Ritzville, WA 99169
- On the "**Confirm**" page – Click "**Submit Enrollment**" at the bottom of the page.
- If you have finished entering enrollment information for your family members, log-out.

Note: *It's very important that you are officially participating with a chartered 4-H Club or recognized 4-H Family Group. The General (Head) 4-H Leader for your PRIMARY 4-H Club must "CONFIRM" your enrollment information for the 2018-2019 4-H year before your enrollment will be "accepted" by the County 4hOnline administrator. Enrollment fees for "accepted" Lincoln Co. 4-H youth members enrolling in Clubs/Family 4-H groups who met the 2018 4-H Silent Auction participation requirement will be covered by the Lincoln Co. 4-H Leaders' Council. Enrollments for "confirmed" youth, who are NOT in a club or group covered by the Li. Co. 4-H Leaders' Council for enrollment fees, will be accepted as soon as your Enrollment Fee Check and "Check Enclosure Form" is received at the Extension Office OR Credit Card Payment is verified in 4hOnline.

Attention General (Head) 4-H Leaders: When you review this year's information for your youth members, please note if any are participating in additional clubs besides yours. **PLEASE Communicate with the Extension Office(s) and/or the General Leader(s) of the other clubs before "Confirming" any members enrolling in multiple clubs.**
