2. Complete the Happy Trails or South Camp entry form prior to the entry deadline.
 - a. Submit both the entry form and campership to the 4-H Office at the same time.
 - b. On the entry form in the money area of the form. Put "Applied for campership."
 - i. 222 N. Havana St. Spokane WA 99202
3. **Each youth must answer the following short essay questions in their best penmanship and grammar.**
 - a. Tell us about yourself and your horse.
 - b. Name, club, age, school, horse's names, age, breed.
 - c. Why do want to attend this camp?
 - d. How could this campership help your family in this time of need?
