Annual Series of Activities (Outputs)

- Cattle pregnancy testing and fall husbandry (calves needed)
- Winter animal science workshops: Reproduction, meats, & nutrition
- Winter skills test
- Skills sheet recognition (winter “banquet”)
- Spring calving
- Horsemanship & low stress sorting clinic (calves needed)
- Ranch roping & animal husbandry workshop (calves needed)
- Summer ride nights (weekly). June-August Opportunity for new and veteran youth to practice horsemanship, ranch roping, & low stress sorting. (calves needed)
- Teen Horse Camp: Overnight 4 nights. Leadership, cattle industry workshops, advanced animal science
 - Older, more advanced youth only. Plus they plan the main camp.
 - (calves needed)
- Overnight trips: Montana, Idaho, Oregon, and of course WA.
 - Bull Test Sale
 - Feed lot
 - Artificial insemination companies
 - Horsemanship clinics
 - Purebred & commercial ranches
 - Supplement/grain distributors
- Main Camp: Overnight 3 nights focused on horsemanship, ranch roping, low stress sorting, animal science, and range science. (calves needed)
- Summer skills test (calves needed)
- Fall skills test (calves needed)
